Who we are

We are Utiq SA/NV (“Utiq”), the controller of your personal information.

Personal information we process

When you visit and interact with www.utiq.com or contact us, we will collect the following information:

- Your contact details, such as your name, email address, company, and content of your query where applicable (for example, if you complete the “Get in touch” form).

How we use your personal information and our legal basis to do so

Responding to your requests

We will use your personal information, to the extent that you have provided us with it, to respond to your requests, including to any queries you submit to us.

We do this based on our legitimate business interest to respond to your requests and manage our engagement with you.

How we share and store your information

Where applicable, we share your information with companies engaged to perform services for us and assist us, such as to operate the site.

We do not transfer information outside of the UK or the EEA. If this changes, we will provide you with further details on why it is necessary and any relevant safeguards by updating this section.

We will keep information you provide to us only as long as it is relevant to manage our engagement with you.

Where we share or store your personal information, we will make sure appropriate protection is in place to protect your personal information in line with data protection laws.

Your rights

Right of access – You have the right to ask us for a copy of the personal information we hold about you and how it has been processed.

Right to rectification – You have the right to ask us that personal information we hold about you is corrected.

Right to erasure – You have the right to ask us to delete your personal information in certain circumstances.

Right to restriction of processing – You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

Right to data portability – You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

Right to object – You have the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.
